The second part of the evening will feature *Children of A Vanished World*, a multi-media production including soprano and tenor accompanied by pianist, violinist, cellist, clarinetist and dramatic narration. The work brings to life Roman Vishniac's haunting and powerful photographs from the 1930's of the Jewish *shtetls* throughout Eastern Europe.
