

Join us for a dialogue between **Thomas Mazanec** (East Asian Languages & Cultural Studies) and **Xiaorong Li** (East Asian Languages & Cultural Studies) about Mazanec's new book, *Poet-Monks: The Invention of Buddhist Poetry in Medieval China*.

In *Poet-Monks*, Mazanec traces the historical development of the poet-monk as a distinct actor in the Chinese literary world, arguing for the importance of religious practice in medieval literature.

Thomas Mazanec is Associate Professor of East Asian Languages & Cultural Studies at UC Santa Barbara. He researches premodern Chinese literature and religion as well as their encounters with other cultures.
