How can we revitalize minority politics while making the fight against discrimination beneficial for all? Bruno Perreau proposes thinking about minority experiences relationally. Legal provisions that protect gender can be used to protect race; those that protect disability can protect age, sexual orientation, or class, and so on. This is what Perreau calls intrasectionality, a new concept and an innovative legal strategy to tackle today's political challenges. *Audience Q&A and a reception will follow.*

Bruno Perreau is the Cynthia L. Reed Professor of French Studies at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He is the author of 13 books on French and US institutions, bioethics, family policies, queer cultures, minority politics, and contemporary theories of justice.



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
